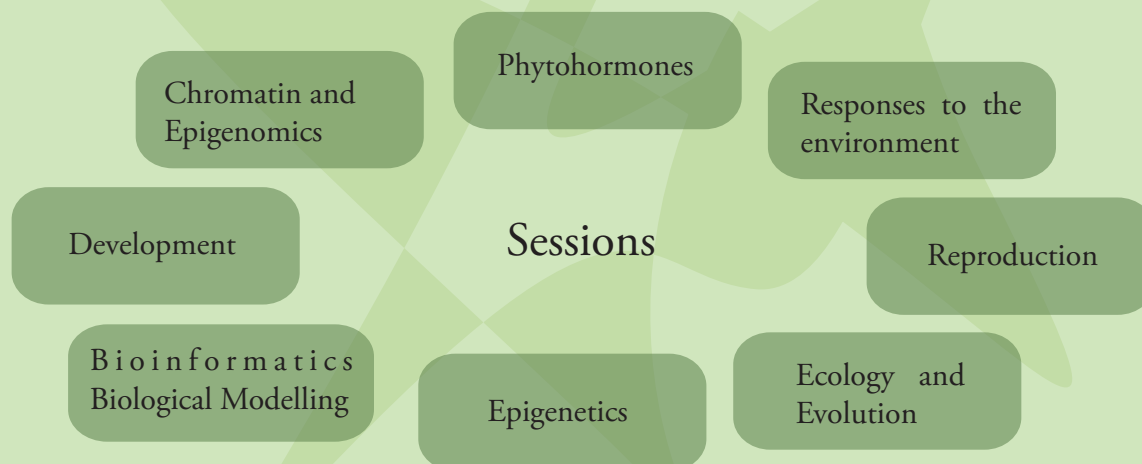
June 20-23rd 2016, Oslo, Norway
