1622.2 The student elections spring 2016

Case preparation: Pål Adrian Ryen

Purpose:

Elect a new president and vice president of the student board as well as two representatives to the University Board.

Background:

Student Board:

This spring there will be a new electronic ballot for the election of president, vice president of the Student Board. Position involves to be a case presenter for the Student Parliament meetings, follow up on decisions made by the Student Parliament, represent the Parliament between meetings and work especially with the reorganisation of NMBU and the Student Parliament during the coming reorganizational phase. The Student Board consists of 6 members; president, vice president, international officer, welfare officer, marketing officer and board member. The president and vice president have full time positions, while the other members of the board study as well. The Student Board is a collegial organ, which means that all members of the board are equal. The Student Board also has their own organisational secretary.

University Board:

NMBUs University Board includes two students. One of each gender and one from each campus. The University Board is the highest organ at NMBU and have the responsibility for the whole university. Mainly the Board work on strategies, economy, steering, organising, goals and reporting.

The Board consists of students, employees and external representatives. During the first 4 years as NMBU the Board has an external chairmen, while rector is the Boards secretary.

The student representatives participates at pre-meetings before each board meeting. They also participate at Top meetings and the student parliament. The university board representatives have an obligation to report to the student parliament. They also participate at senate forum and meet representatives from other University Boards.

Permanent representatives:

The representatives begin 1st of July 2016 and the position is for 1 year.

1623 Statute cases

1623.1 Implementation of mid-term evaluation

Case preparation: Andreas Reme Gunnestad

Purpose:

Give the students at NMBU a better possibility to make an impact on the teaching method and academic setup.

Background:

The student council at HH (Business school) are wondering if there is interest among the student parliament to implement a broader course evaluation. We believe it can be beneficial to implement an evaluation of the courses mid-term. Most courses only offer an evaluation at the end of each course.

- The lecturer can receive relevant feedback while the students are still taking the course.
- The interest to make amendments to the teaching method and academic setup may increase.
- Many students don't see the point in answering the course evaluation when they are finished with the course.
- Easier for "shy" students to inform the lecturer of possible problems and how the course is setup.
- Avoid going through other channels that can be time consuming for the student.

The Study committee has already discussed this and support from the Student Parliament will underline the importance of this case.

Proposing resolution:

The Student Parliament wishes to speed up the work on implementing a mid-term evaluation.

1623.2 Instruction for the Student Parliament Election Committee at NMBU

Purpose:

The Election Committee believes that it's time to make some changes to the committees guidelines, to highlight what they should focus on, add a point about the control committee and secure a functioning student democracy at NMBU.

Background:

The instruction was reviewed at the first meeting for the committee and turned out that some parts of the instruction should be changed. Especially important is the work to establish a control committee, because as it is today, the Election committee does not report to anyone and that is not ideal for a democracy. The student democracy is not very large at NMBU, therefore it is often difficult to find candidates to all the positions. Therefore, it is a wish to create best possible relevant elections and give the election committee the possibility to run for an election, but without recommendation from the committee.

Another addition is a point about more determined tasks for each member, this is to give the committee some guidelines during the start-up phase.

Suggested resolution:

The Student Parliament ratifies the new instruction for the Election Committee.

1623.3 Allocating Welfare Funds for the spring semester 2016

Purpose:

To allocate Welfare Funds for the spring semester 2016.

Background:

Each year the Student Parliament allocates Welfare Funds to teams and fraternities at NMBU. A committee appointed by the Student Board and the Student Parliament, according to the regulations, has prepared a suggestion for the allocation of Welfare Funds.

The Committee for spring 2015 consists of:

- Halvor Kongevold (Welfare Officer of the Student Board)
- Jonas Thorsen (International Officer of the Student Board)
- Elisabeth Bøhmer Prøsch (Head of Economy at Samfunnet)
- Erling Bjurbeck (Board Member of the SiÅs-Board)
- Kristian Brathagen (previous Welfare Officer of the Student Board)
- Beate Bjørgan (elected by the Student Parliament)
- Tord Haug (elected by the Student Parliament)

The Student Parliament may allocate NOK 400.000 in Welfare Funds 2016.

During spring, the committee decides the amount that should be reserved for Student Society Meetings. This year NOK 44 527 are reserved for these meetings. 8% of the Welfare Funds will be allocated in the Autumn 2016 at Student Parliament meeting no. 5, and the leftovers will be allocated at the Student Parliament meeting no. 2 in spring.

The Committees evaluation:

The proposed allocation for 2016 (appendix 2) and the overview of applications (appendix 3) are enclosed. This spring 62 applications were received, and the total amount applied for was NOK 562 372. Two applications were submitted after the deadline, these are not taken into consideration.

The committee proposes to allocate 323 473 as welfare funds and 44 527 as Student Society meetings. The amount for Society meetings has decreased from last year, the reason for this is that last year's money was not fully used.

Some applications were submitted without appendixes, accounting or a budget. The Welfare Officer gave the applicants an opportunity to correct their mistakes.

Many of the applications had insufficient accounting and budgets. The Committee aimed at awarding student teams and fraternities that were active, to support open events on campus and the committee decided not to support those events that can apply for funds from the Society meetings. Most of the funds are branded so we can ensure that the funds go to events we believe should be funded by the Welfare funds.

Proposed resolution:

The Student Parliament ratifies the allocation of Welfare Funds for spring 2016 as presented in appendix 3.

The members of the Central Admission Committee mainly assess applicants through The Norwegian Universities and Colleges Admission Service who can't have their points calculated according to the grading rules in high school. The Central Admission Committee makes a discretionary assessment of the applicants and decides whether or not they get an offer to study at NMBU.

The Committee consists of one representative from each faculty, one representative from the Committee of Study Issues and two student representatives. The committee usually has one meeting each year, in the beginning of July.

1625.2 Electing representatives to the Board of Complaints

Case preparation: Election committee

Purpose:

Background:

We need two representatives to the Board of Complaints and to deputy representatives. Examples of cases that the Board of Complaints handle are complaints about grading, complaints about formal errors in exams and annulment of exams or tests. If there is a reason to believe that someone has cheated at exams or papers, it is the Board of Complaints that will handle the case. They also handle cases regarding lectures and study environment.

This position is well suited for students studying law.

Begin 1st of July 2016 and have the position for 1 year. There will be meetings when needed, in 2014 there were 10 meetings, in 2015 there were 8 meetings.

1627 Evaluation of the meeting

Instruction for the Student Parliament Election Committee NMBU

Ratified at Student Parliament xxxxx

"Elections" are interpreted as all elections at Student Parliament and all electronic ballots where the whole student mass has the right to vote. Which means, not institute or faculty elections.

Purpose

- The election committee is responsible for those elections which are within the Student democracy and are carried out according to the statutes, especially chapter 5: elections.

Composition and meetings

- The election committee reports to the control committee
- The election committee consists of four members.
The organisational secretary at the Student Board functions as a secretary for the election committee without the right to vote.
- The election committee elects their own leader.
- **The leader** **All members** of the election committee and the Secretary can summon for meeting. The leader can summon for meetings without the secretary if desirable. All directly elected members of the committee have a duty to attend all meetings.
- The election committee can vote when a minimum of 60% of the members are present.
- Members of the election committee can not **run** **be recommended** for elections during active period of the committee, with the exception of re-election to the election committee.

Duties

- The election committees is responsible for finding good candidates to all elections that the committee is responsible for.
- The election committee will cooperate with the student councils to get an overview over possible candidates.
- The election committee will search among the students at NMBU to find good candidates for the elections, and make sure that all directions of study, both campuses and both gender are represented among the candidates.
- The election committee is case presenter for all cases with elections at the Student Parliament.

- The election committee can make recommendations **for elections**. The members of the elections committee can use dissent for a recommendation if the members disagree **or if there is a question of competence**.
- The election committee will, in cooperation with the student councils and the student board, make sure that relevant information **reaches all** students about current/open positions, and encourage candidates to run for elections.
- **The election committee should strive to get presentations of the candidates in the case papers and at Student Parliament.**

Other

- The members of the election committee should be invited and attend the Student Parliament meetings and events.
