Parking for guests at Campus Ås

Access

Parking spaces have been created at the Bioteknologibygningen (BTB [Biotechnology building]). Guest parking spaces are signposted with a black P on a white background. The signs have been placed at the exit from Kirkevegen (County road 56) up to the parking area for guests.

Free parking - don't forget the ticket

Between 08.00 and 17.00 on working days, guests can take a free parking ticket from the machine located at the centre of the guest parking area. The ticket should be clearly visible in the vehicle's front windscreen. The ticket is valid for the whole day.

When the guest parking area is full

If there are no parking spaces in the guest parking area, please contact the operations centre at Estates and Facilities on tel. 67 23 07 77 for help. Opening hours for the operations centre are 08.00 to 15.00 (Friday 08.00-13.00) during the period from 15 May to 14 September, and 08.00 to 15.45 (Friday 08.00-13.00) from 15 September to 14 May.

Guest parking over several days

Guests who need a guest parking space near the institute or department they are visiting should contact the relevant institute or department for more information.

Service vehicles

Uniformed service vehicles (such as DHL and Ricoh) can park in spaces marked for service vehicles and employees. Private vehicles used as service vehicles must be registered and have digital parking permits. Special parking arrangements for visitors to NIBIO at Campus Ås

Special guest parking spaces have been designated for visitors to NIBIO at Høgskolevegen 7. Their vehicles must be registered with NIBIO at Høgskolevegen 7; see signposting on site.

Parking map

Parking spaces at Campus Ås are shown on the parking map. Please note that, apart from guest parking spaces, digital parking permits are required for employees or students to use charging points and motorcycle/moped spaces; see signposting on site.

Parking for guests at Campus Adamstua

Separate spaces for guests are signposted. No stickers or parking permits are required for parking in these spaces. Parking is not permitted between the hours of 24.00 and 06.00 every day.

The parking regulations are listed on signs at the entrances to the campus. The parking regulations apply all day, every day.
