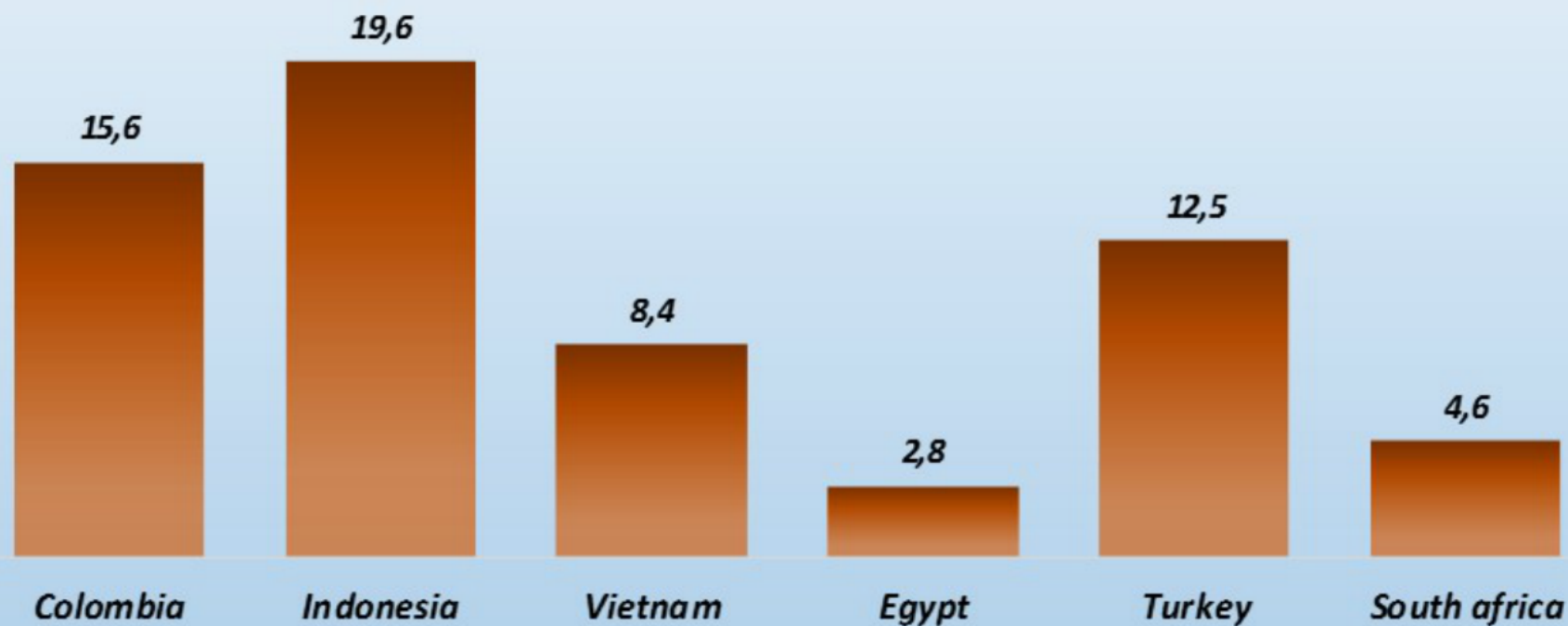

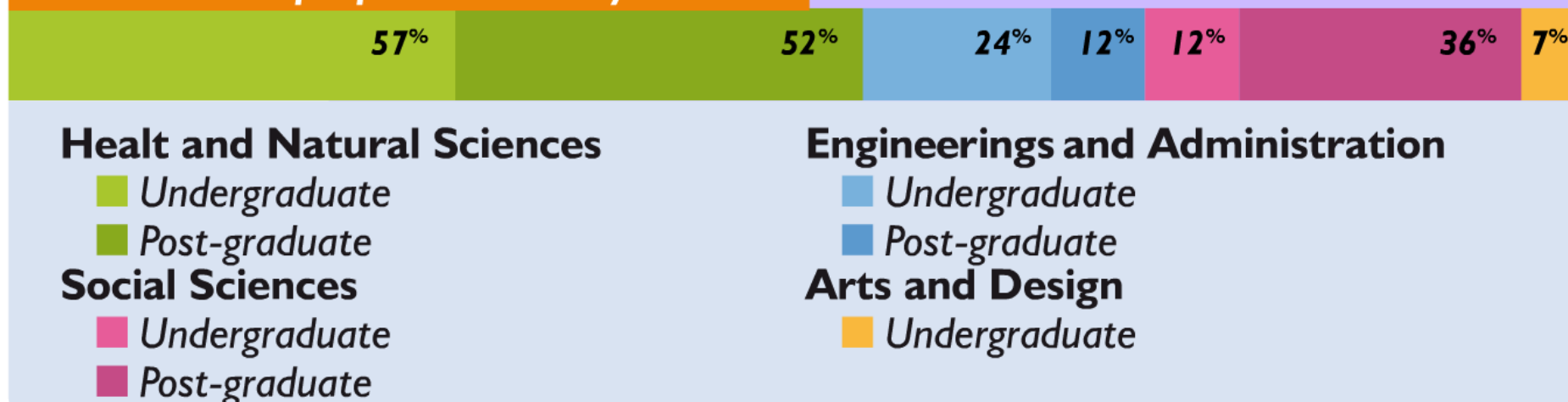
Student population by level

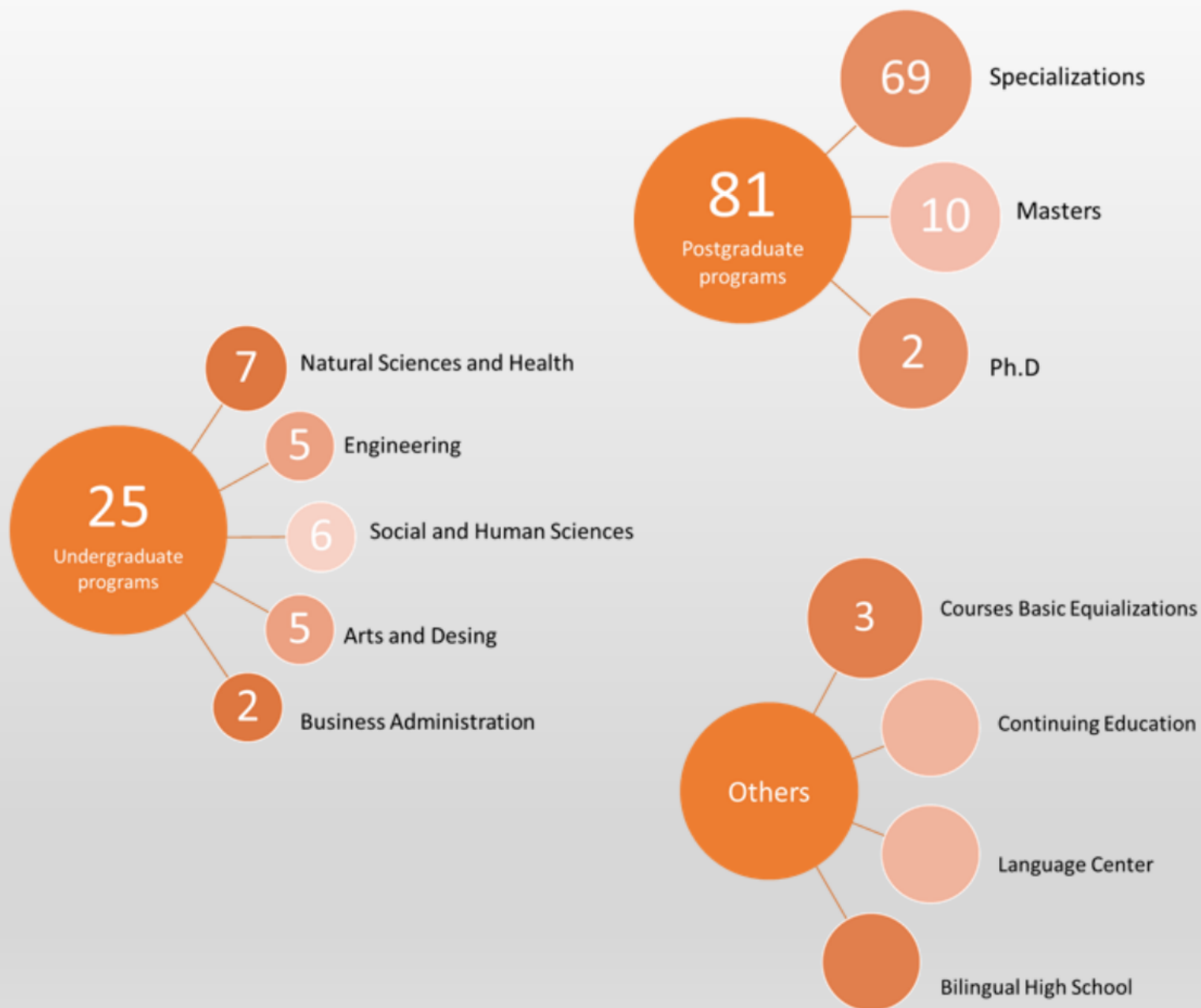

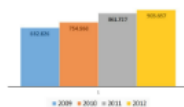

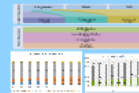
