Reporting to the Police – Non-European Nationals

Reporting to the Police

Non-European nationals who applied for a study permit (residence permit) at a Norwegian Embassy (in some cases Danish or Swedish Embassy) in the home country, should report to the Follo Police Station in Ski within 7 days of arrival, or at the very least book an appointment with the police. Once the permit has been granted, students should book an appointment through the Norwegian Directorate of Immigration's (UDI's) Application Portal at <u>www.udi.no/en</u>. In most cases, it is the same portal used to submit the initial permit application. If you have not submitted your permit application through the Application Portal or are encountering problems, you can email the Follo Police Station at <u>folloutl@politiet.no</u> to book the appointment. The International Office at the Police Station is open Tuesday through Friday, and closed on Mondays. It is now also possible to visit other police stations in the Follo district, these include: <u>Romerike</u>, <u>Sarpsborg</u> and <u>Askim</u> Police Stations.
