




## How to become an excellent researcher?

### Do you need a coach?



Mentoring is peer tutoring, normally involves an older person providing assistance to younger people. The aim of mentoring is to provide through a supportive relationship personal, emotional, cognitive and psychological growth. (Hattie, 2009, p. 187). *Hattie* found that mentoring had a close to zero effect on performance outcomes but slightly larger impact on student attitudes, motivation and involvement
