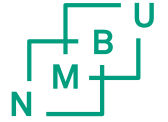

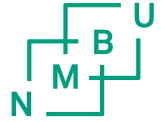

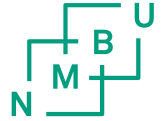


education in brief



- Three years full time study, equal to 180 ECTS
The course part is measured in ECTS, NOT the research and thesis
- Research work equal to 2 ½ years full time work
- Academic training / Required coursework
30-60 ECTS dependent on faculty & PhD programme
- Doctoral thesis in English (or Norwegian)
 - a) Introductory part (kappe) & 3-4 manuscripts/articles
 - b) Monograph
- Doctoral exam:
a trial lecture on a given topic, and a public defence of the thesis

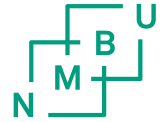

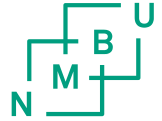
