### 59 1873.1 Proposition for Student Work Space for LANDSAM

#### 60 **Purpose:**

61 To approve the resolution

62

#### 63 **Background:**

64 On Monday 12th of November, it was announced via canvas a policy change regarding  
65 allocated work spaces for Master's students in LANDSAM. The announcement as  
66 administrative move that is supposed to answer to the lack of working spaces for students in  
67 general. Up until now, the policy has been that every Master's student gets an allocated work  
68 space while writing their thesis. The new change to this previous policy is political and agreed  
69 upon without the involvement of students. Policies that affect students, by cutting down on  
70 available resources should be decided together with the student body, and students' concerns  
71 should be a priority.

72

#### 73 **The Importance Of A Work Space:**

74 Having an allocated work space creates an important framework for Master's students. It is a  
75 permanent office where the research and work derived from it can be developed in a  
76 consistent environment. Having a stable working space simply creates the desirable physical  
77 predictability that helps stabilize the writing process. Thesis writing is a process that is already  
78 highly unpredictable and stressful. It is essential for students to have their books, printed texts,  
79 writing and drawing tools, computers, food, mind maps and other daily resources close at

hand. It is unreasonable to expect Master's students to carry this amount of items with them every day from one place to another. In addition, searching for a work space reduces the amount of time set for the thesis work. Writing a thesis is doing research, which is producing work on behalf of NMBU. We therefore require allocated working spaces, as we were promised when we began our degrees at NMBU.

The Student Parliament therefore proposes that:

- Allocated desk for students writing their Master's thesis stays as a policy
- Changes in policies that affect students should be consulted first with relevant committees such as the educational committee If there is a change in work space policy, that Master's students must be given another allocated desk where they can work

### **The Student Boards proposal**

The Student Parliament decides against the proposal, and proposing an amendment.

Student Parliament received a written amendment to the case during the meeting from the Student Board. The recommendation from the Student Board is to approve the amendment.

No questions of a clarifying nature.

Debate:

Biovit: Are we meant to vote now? Need some time to read through the document.

Mina: Should we not work with this now for the current Master Students?

Control Committee: The plan is already put into action. The Student Board can work with this already, even without a formal approval in this case.

Student Board: The reason for this amendment is because it has already happened – The Board is currently working with it.

Since the proposed amendment presents extensive changes in content to the resolution, it was a wish from the representatives to discuss the proposal with their Student Councils. It is proposed to move the case to the next Student Parliament.

The case was approved by a majority vote, with 11 for, 4 against, and 4 abstained from casting a vote.

The case will be presented again at Student Parliament 1.

129 The kick-off conference was set to 2.-3. February at Student Parliament 3. The veterinary faculty has  
130 cell biology in January and an exam in the start of February, which means they have not been able to  
131 participate earlier. This is very unfortunate, and we therefore suggest that we move the kick-off to  
132 the weekend 9.-10. February so that they can participate as well.

134 **Proposed decision**

135 The Student Parliament decides that the date of the kick-off conference is moved from the weekend  
136 2.-3. February to the weekend 9.-10. February.

163 All positions in the Student Parliament's Student Board last for 1 year, and those elected at the  
164 Constituent Student Parliament start their position on January 1, 2019. In addition to the  
165 duties of the position, you will sit in the board with 5 other members. Student Board meetings

happen every week, as well as regular office hours. In addition to this, you will have Student Parliament meetings, and other possible meetings/workshops/projects.

Questions from the Room:

MINA: Are we impartial from voting on whether we can vote on ourselves or not?

Comment from the benches: Wants a more thorough explanation as to why impartiality is discussed, so it will be easier for new representatives to understand the issue at hand.

## **Election of the Welfare Officer**

### **Background:**

The Facilitators, also known as the Chairmen of the Student Parliament, are elected once a year and sit from New Year to New Year. The main responsibility of the Chairmen is simply to ensure that the Student Parliament goes through the planned agenda in an orderly fashion, and within a reasonable amount of time.

The Chairmen needs to have experience in leading meetings and should preferably have been a part of bigger meetings or many previous Student Parliaments. Normally the Chairmen have a meeting with the president and vice president of the Student Board where they go over the agenda and make a time management plan. Up until now there has been no Control Committee in the Student Parliament, and therefore the Chairmen have had an important role when it is unclear if the Student Parliament is following the regulations and protocol. It is still important

318 that the Chairmen follow regulated meeting practices, and it is therefore important that they  
319 are well-versed in this. To work as a Chairman is interesting and enriching. The position gives  
320 both experience with structured meeting leadership and a good insight into the Student  
321 Democracy's work here at NMBU.

356 The Election Committee has the responsibility of finding candidates for all positions at student  
357 parliament and other committees at the university level. Together with the Student Board, they  
358 market chosen candidates and prepare election cases for the student parliaments case papers.  
359 The election committee has the opportunity to submit their recommendations, and only does  
360 so when they find it necessary. The members of the election committee do not have the  
361 possibility of running for positions during their time on the committee, except for to re-run for  
362 the election committee. The members of the committee must attend the Student Parliament's  
363 meetings and arrangements.  
364

365 As a member of the Election Committee you play an important role in the student democracy!  
366 You work actively to reach out to all students at NMBU throughout the whole year to promote  
367 the different positions. You can expect close cooperation with the Student Board and Student  
368 Councils at the university. As a committee member you will work a lot with social media, email,  
369 and designing campaigns.
