35 2022.2 Student Elections 2020

36 *Case responsible: The Student Board*

37

38 **Purpose:**

39 To inform the Student Parliament on the upcoming election of the 3 new members of the Student
40 Board, as well as one permanent female representative + substitute for the University Board and
41 each of the faculty boards.

42

43 **The Student Board:**

44 The Student Board is the Student Democracy's highest organ between Student Parliament
45 meetings. They carry out the daily tasks of the Student Democracy, and follow up on decisions
46 made by the Student Parliament. The Student Board prepares case papers for the Student
47 Parliament. The board shall from 01.07 consists of 3 members: president and 2 board members, in
48 full time positions. The Student Board is a "collective" board, which means that all members are
49 equal within the board. The Student Board also has an organizational secretary.

50

51 An electronic vote for the new Student Board will be conducted during the Student Election in 20th
52 - 24th of April.

53

54 The president has responsibility for strategic matters, and represents NMBU students in the
55 highest levels of leadership at NMBU and outside of the university. The other members have
56 responsible for organizational matters and work on educational policies. They also work with other
57 representatives in the student democracy to ensure good training and information flow within the
58 organization.

59

60 **The University Board:**

61 The University Board at NMBU is the highest decision making organ at NMBU and consists of an
62 external committee leader, and committee members that are both internal and external to NMBU.

63

64 The University Board works mostly with strategic matters, budgets, goal setting, reporting, and
65 organizational development at an overarching level. The University Board has 7-8 meetings per
66 year. Apart from this, members should meet up for other high level meetings and seminars that
67 concern the work of the board. The Committee members must also report their work to the
68 Student Parliament, and should be represented during parliament meetings.

69 From students, there should be two main representatives and two substitutes for them. In
70 accordance to regulations there needs to be an equal gender representation, and it has been
71 decided that women are elected in the spring and men in the autumn.

72 Students who wish to run for the University Board should have experience in committees (institute
73 committees, faculty committees, or similar) or board work experience at a higher level (UFU/USU).

74 **The Faculty Board:**

75 The Faculty Board is the faculties' highest decision making organ, and consists of scientific
76 employees, external board members and two student representatives. They work on cases of
77 strategic character and have approximately four meetings a year.

78 Just like the University Board there needs to be equal gender representation, and women are
79 elected in the spring and men in the autumn.

80

81 The representatives in all the boards are elected by electronic vote (Student Elections), start July 1st
82 2020, and sit for a period of one year.

93 **Purpose:**

94 Approve allocation of Welfare Funds for spring 2019

95

96 **Background:**

97 The Student Parliament will on Student Parliament 2 approve an allocation of 88,8 % of the
98 funds set aside to Welfare Funds. This year the will be 444 000 kr. From these fund there will
99 also be set aside funds for community meeting funds.

100 The committee for allocation of Welfare Funds suggest to allocate 313 870 kr to student teams
101 and organizations and allocate 130 870 kr to community meeting funds (see attachment).

102 The committee have chosen to increase the percentage of funds for the fall allocation (from 8%
103 in 2019 to 11,2% in 2020), to facilitate the increase of student teams and organizations that
104 will come to Ås from Adamstuen at the beginning of the school year of 2020/2021.

127 **Purpose:**
128 Adopt the Study Quality Document for the Student Parliament at NMBU

129
130 **Background:**
131 In the 2020 action plan adopted by the Student Parliament, it says "*3.8 Make a plan and start*
132 *working so that the Student Parliament can establish political documents or platforms within*
133 *areas policies are needed.*"

134 We therefore want to start by adopting a Study Quality Document. The document was
135 discussed at SP1 and the Student Board recommends that the Student Parliament adopt the
136 attached proposal.

137
138 It is preferable that the document should reflect the entire student body, regardless of study
139 program. The document is valid for 5 years, so the contents should be timeless enough to hold
140 its own even in the future.

152 **Purpose:**
153 Approve new instructions for the Student Board.

154
155 **Background:**
156 The Student Parliament has decided that the Student Board shall comprise of three people
157 working full time from the summer 2020; one president and two Student Board members. Due
158 to this, the instruction for the Student Board must be revised.

159 The working instruction was put forth for clarifying questions at SP1. None of the points have
160 been changed since Student Parliament 1, but the work tasks have been categorized after input
161 at the meeting.

162 There are few changes in the tasks of the Student Board. The largest difference is that the tasks
163 are no longer tied to a person, but that the tasks must be divided inside the Student Board
164 elected by the students at NMBU.

165 If the instruction is approved, it will come into effect when the new Student Board starts their
166 terms, 01.07.20.

178 **Purpose:**

179 Approve new framework for the working year of the Student Democracy

180

181 **Background:**

182 Due to the changes in the composition of the Student Board starting this summer, it is
183 necessary to revise the framework for the working year of the Student Democracy. Most of the
184 changes are tied to this.

185 In addition, we see it as favourable to move the election of participants for NSO's annual
186 meeting, as one usually is not informed of the number of delegates you can elect before after
187 Student Parliament 5. The Student Board therefore suggests moving the election to SP6, as well
188 as removing the specification of how many participants to elect. This is because the number of
189 participants might vary from year to year.

190

191 The Student Board also suggests adding the election of student representatives for the
192 Learning Environment Committee (LMU) at Student Parliament 3. This change is tied to the
193 proposal made at the LMU-meeting 26.02.20 regarding changing the statutes for LMU tied to
194 student representation.

196 **Proposed decision:**

205 **Attachment 6** Proposed Environmental Policy Document

206

207 **Purpose:**

208 Discuss the proposed content and what the Student Parliament wants to include in an
209 Environmental Policy document. Provide input for the final environmental policy document
210 that will be passed at ST3.

211

212 **Background:**

213 The Action Plan Adopted by the Student Parliament states "*3.8 Create a plan and start the work
214 for the Student Parliament to establish political documents or platforms in areas where there is a
215 need for policy.*" At Student Parliament 1, it was decided that we will introduce political
216 documents, and that they will be processed during a timespan of two student parliaments.

217 Therefore, we will discuss the Environmental Policy document at this meeting, and the final
218 recommendation of the Environmental policy document will be passed from the Student
219 Board on Student Parliament 3 . There is a wish for the document to be reflective of the entire
220 student body, regardless of study program. The document is supposed to be valid for 5 years,
221 implying the content should be timeless enough to move forward in time.

222 On February 17th 2020, the Sustainability Committee was created by the Student Board, which
223 has been the leading force in the drafting of this proposal. The Sustainability Committee is an
224 advisory group, consisting of 4 students and one representative from the Student Board. Their
225 intention is to submit proposals and input to the Student Board, which then will recommend a
226 comprehensive proposal for ST3.

244 **Background:**

245 Not all who wish to study at NMBU by applying through samordna opptak meet the grade
246 requirements with their grades from secondary school. It is therefore necessary to have a central
247 admissions board that can assess and rank the applications and decide which students will be
248 offered admission to NMBU. The committee will consist of one faculty representative from each
249 faculty, one representative from the Education Committee, and two student representatives. The
250 committee has previously had about one meeting a year, in the beginning of July.

260 2025.2 Election of representatives to the board of complaints

261 *Case responsible: The Student Board*

262 **Purpose:**

263 To elect two main representatives and two deputy representatives to the board of complaints.

264 **Background:**

265 We need two students to sit in the board of complaints, and two deputies for these students. This is
266 a paid position where one gets paid for two hours of preparation time, in addition to the entire
267 meeting. A meeting lasts an entire working day. The board of complaints amongst other things
268 handles complaints over formal errors with exams, and annulments of exams or tests. It is also the
269 board of complaints that handles complaints about teaching and the learning environment. The
270 position can be fitting for students interested in law, but that is not a requirement. The position
271 begins on July 1, 2020 and lasts one year. There is about 6-8 meetings a year.

5. NMBU must use peer review of the teaching in all courses at least once per semester to ensure the quality and to give educators formative feedback.

6. Exchange shall be the norm and everyone should have the opportunity to travel on exchange.

7. NMBU needs a system to opt out of going, instead of having to opt in for exchange.

8. Education shall provide the student with relevant knowledge and competence in their field of study

9. NMBU must make good arrangements for academic organizations to contribute to a good and inclusive academic environment.

- 466 with instructions and other governance documents adopted by the Student Parliament.
- 467 - The Student Board will work with and for the impact of the Student Parliament's policy.
- 468 - The Student Board is preparatory and advisory organ for the Student Parliament. The Student
- 469 Board shall recommend cases to the Student Parliament.
- 470 - The Student Board is responsible for conducting Student Council dinners before the Student
- 471 Parliaments.
- 472 - Everyone at The Student Board is responsible for creating a good working environment and a
- 473 good collaboration.
- 474 - The Student Board shall chair committees set up by the Student Board itself, as well as the
- 475 housing environment committee, the committee for the allocation of welfare funds and
- 476 inclusion funds.
- 477 - The Student Board will work to ensure that information for students and union
- 478 representatives is up-to-date and available in both Norwegian and English.
- 479 - The Student Board will follow up the committee for the selection of the semester's best
- 480 lecturer.
- 481 - The Student Board will follow up the Student Councils and committees at the Student
- 482 Democracy, as well as representatives in the Student Parliament.

484 **Communication and availability**

- 485 - The Student Board is responsible for making available the reports of the committees that are

- 490 Democracy at NMBU, as well as relevant national student affairs.

- 492 connection with the Student Parliament papers before each Student Parliament.
- 493 - The Student Board is responsible for communicating and providing information to the
- 494 Student Councils.

496 **NMBU and other actors**

- 497 - The Student Board is the bridge between the Student Parliament, Student Councils,

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675 **Proposed Environmental Policy document for the Student**
676 **Parliament at NMBU**

677 This document contains the requirements all students at NMBU have regarding their environment, and
678 their surroundings.

679 *NMBU operation:*

- 680 1. NMBU will annually develop a climate accounting and climate budgets according to the
681 Oslo model, with goals for emission reduction, distribution of responsibility, and
682 reporting in relation with other financial reporting.
- 683 2. The establishment of at least a 100% post, as an environmental advisor at the
684 university.
- 685 3. All NMBU vehicles, with the exception of agricultural machinery, will be fossil-free by
686 the end of 2021.
- 687 4. NMBU shall strive to have food with low or positive climate footprint. Suggestions:
688 Introduce vegonorm at all events under the directions of the university, as well as focus
689 on increased use of locally produced food.
- 690 5. Procurement: Environmental impact should be weighed by at least 40% when
691 purchasing, and requirements should be set for emission-free transport from suppliers.
- 692 6. BREEAM Excellent must be the minimum standard for all buildings at NMBU. Material
693 reuse must be prioritized and plus houses should be desired.
- 694 7. NMBU will phase out all use of fossil fuels for heating within 2020. Through smart
695 environmental management of buildings reduce all energy use by 10%. All purchased
696 power must have guarantees of origin.
- 697 8. NMBU's funds should not be invested in fossil energy, but rather managed in a way that
698 stimulates green growth and development.
- 699 9. NMBU shall have a zero target for the destruction of nature, food soil, and marsh.
700 Biological diversity must be safeguarded in decisions regarding land management.
- 701 10. NMBU's consumption and waste management will be based on the EU's waste directive
702 and the waste pyramid, this including prioritizing waste reduction, recycling, and
703 recycling

704 *Environment and Sustainability in Education:*

- 705 11. Fix-corner for students / Green hub. Social events that also have academic content, a
706 greater push from the university. Youtube channel, using social media to an even
707 greater extent, both for students and for professors. Green hubs, thinking hubs,
708 collaboration.
- 709 12. Sustainability must be present in all courses. Suggestion: implement as part of the intro
710 course in the august block as a video lecture with compulsory quiz.
- 711 13. Academic learning for practice
- 712 14. NMBU should strive for a comprehensive offering of digital curriculum. E-books and
713 e-compendia should be available in all subjects
- 714 15. Emphasise the focus on interdisciplinarity, increased interdisciplinary cooperation for
715 professional breadth and quality. Suggestion: Urban agriculture
- 716 16. Electronic exams, spare sheets, and relevant use of tools used in teaching. Ex. R-studio

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718 *Research:*

- 719 17. NMBU should be a leading university at an international level when it comes to research
- 720 regarding environment, climate, and sustainability
- 721 18. Sustainability should be included in research and be an overarching goal
- 722 19. Focus area: Vegetable protein sources
- 723 20. Focus area: Vertical agriculture
- 724 21. Focus area: Lab meat
