Access to campus for students and staff

- Reading room in the Clock Build. Gradual opening of the 3rd Floor as from Monday 19th of May for up to 100 students.
- Home office is valid

Campus Development

Campus Adamstuen:

- The Plan for moving to Ås
 - Statsbygg plans to start the transfer of the building to NMBU and the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine from September 1, 2020
- Building 155 The Equine clinic and ambulatory clinic in Building 156 are scheduled to be transferred to NMBU on September 1, 2020 while the remaining buildings are scheduled to be transferred on September 30, 2020.
- The equine clinic and ambulatory clinic will thus be the first to use the new buildings.
- Plan C for Relocation means, as previously outlined, the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine will start class at Ås as from January 2021.

INTRANET

The new Intranet is called Mitt NMBU (My NMBU) and will display new articles and a calendar.

Juni 1st: Launching of beta version for the Communication Forum. From June 1st till launch:

- User testing of the site – gradual involvement of all employees, dialogue and feedback form online
- Create editorial guidelines and channel choices – how to use the new intranet as effectively as possible?
- User testing by 20 staff members from the faculties
- Contact with researchers /teachers in this phase
- June 15th: Expand the test group to approx. 60 staff member s of the University Administration
- June 30th: testing all staff
- August 2020: Launch to all staff. Introduction of a new entrance to the intranet. Date for launching depends on the results of the various tests.
