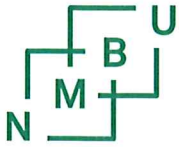

*The COST Action CA18214 'The geography of New Working Spaces and the impact on the periphery' involves 90 research partners from 28 Countries, and 1 COST Near Neighbour Country, Lebanon, and 3 COST International Partner Countries (2 from USA and 1 from Canada) COST Action CA18214 goes from October 1, 2019 to September 30, 2023. The project is led by the Action Chair Ilaria Mariotti, from Politecnico di Milano (Italy) and Vice-Action Chair Pavel Bednar (Tomas Bata University, Czech Republic). ### **Tasks**

The Short-Term Scientific Missions (STSMs) funded by the COST Action at Department of Urban and Regional Planning seeks a researcher for the following tasks: i) analyzing the main location determinants of new working spaces (related to structure and size of the cities, population, territory of a country, socio-cultural issues, digitalization) (see the deliverables D.1.3 and D.1.4 WG1 of CA18214); ii) exploring links between remote working and coworking from different new working spaces (see direct and indirect effects of WG2). Thus, the background of the candidate should be related to the urban studies (such as urban and regional planning, urban and regional economics, economic geography, human geography, architecture and environmental planning).



## Financial Support

The grant of 2500 € is supported by CA18214, and this will cover travels and accommodation, including the quarantine period.
