The Department of Architecture and Urban Studies (DAStU) at the Politecnico di Milano (Polimi) is willing to host a researcher within the Short-Term Scientific Missions (STSM). The STSMs are Mobility and Collaboration Grants that aim to support individual mobility within the network of the COST Action CA18214.

The COST Action CA18214 'The geography of New Working Spaces and the impact on the periphery' involves 90 research partners from 28 Countries, and 1 COST Near Neighbour Country, Lebanon, and 3 COST International Partner Countries (2 from USA and 1 from Canada) COST Action CA18214 goes from October 1, 2019 to September 30, 2023. The project is led by the Action Chair Ilaria Mariotti, from Politecnico di Milano (Italy) and Vice-Action Chair Pavel Bednar (Tomas Bata University. Czech Republic). ## **Tasks**

The Short-Term Scientific Missions (STSMs) funded by the COST Action at Polimi-DAStU seeks a young researcher with an economic geography and regional studies background to fulfil the following tasks, together with the Cost members at Polimi: (i) to help develop an online-questionnaire for managers of the new working spaces (NWS) with a focus on the impact of the Covid and to understand the post-Covid situation and potentials of such spaces, with a focus on the peripheral and remote areas; (ii) to help structure a quantitative methodology for analysing the direct and indirect effects of NSW, building upon data gathered and elaborated within WG1 and WG2 and also the data collected via the questionnaire. She/ he will also explore whether and how NWS have promoted — with or without the help of public subsidies and planning measures: (a) regional competitiveness, (b) resilience and, accordingly, spatial regeneration of peripheral areas via, for instance, retaining knowledge workers and the creative class and social inclusion.

## **Financial Support**

The grant of 2500€ is supported by CA18214, which will cover travels and accommodation (including the quarantine period).
