The STSMs are Mobility and Collaboration Grants that aim to support individual mobility within the network of the COST Action CA18214.

*The COST Action CA18214 'The geography of New Working Spaces and the impact on the periphery' involves 90 research partners from 28 Countries, and 1 COST Near Neighbour Country, Lebanon, and 3 COST International Partner Countries (2 from USA and 1 from Canada). COST Action CA18214 goes from October 1, 2019 to September 30, 2023. The project is led by the Action Chair Ilaria Mariotti, from Politecnico di Milano (Italy) and Vice Action Chair Pavel Bednar, from Tomas Bata University (Czech Republic). ### **Tasks**

The Short-Term Scientific Missions (STSMs) funded by the COST Action at the Department of Public Administration and Regional Development seeks a researcher for the following tasks:

- 1) participation in the creation of a single database on NWS for several countries with comparable indicators (for more information see the deliverable D.1.3 WG1 of CA18214).
- 2) analysing the main location determinants of new working spaces, related to structure and size of the cities, population, territory of a country, socio-cultural issues and digitalization (for more information see the deliverable D.1.3 WG1 of CA18214).
- 3) exploring and analysing of direct and indirect effects of NWS in the area in which they operate (see direct and indirect effects in deliverables D.2.1. and D.2.2 WG2 of CA18214).

Therefore, the background of the candidate should be related to the urban studies (such as urban and regional economics, economic geography, human geography, urban and regional planning, architecture and environmental planning).

### **Financial Support**
