

Dear fellow students

My name is Tilde Dalberg, and I am running for election as a female student representative for the University Board at NMBU. I am 22 years old, and have been here in Ås for four years. I have a bachelor's degree in international environment and development studies, in addition to the fact that I have held a one-year position as a member of the Student Parliament's Student Board (AU), and will now take a master's degree here. I do not feel finished working to represent you as students, and wish to continue with this in the University Board.



With a position on the university board, I will apply what I have learned and experienced, not only as a member of AU, but also as a student. In the year that has passed now, I have sat on and led several committees, committees and groups, both in student democracy and at the university, which has given me a completely unique insight into how NMBU and a university are run. This insight is of great benefit to a board such as the University Board. In my position at AU, it has also been incredibly important for me to use the experiences I have as a student, in addition to listening to the student voice. This will still be important to me if you choose me.

The most important thing about being a student representative is as simple as representing the students. We have a student democracy for a reason, and that is for your voice to be heard. I will therefore take the time to familiarize myself with what the students think about the issues raised, and listen to your opinions. I will also continue the work that has been done to make the student representatives on the University Board visible and easily accessible so that it will be possible to contact us. Something I am really passionate about is that all students should see and feel heard, which in turn will lead to the best possible student life for as many people as possible.

I have held two positions in AU, both as marketing responsible and as a member. In these positions, I have worked to make it easier to express one's opinion, this by making the Student Parliament even more visible, and making it easier to understand .. I have also led the learning environment committee and worked with issues such as marking World Day for mental health and with a project around revising the campus plan. Another thing I have worked for is to focus on mental health, and for the municipality to continue to give money to the health station for young people and students. The list of issues I have worked for is long, and it would have been incredibly exciting to try something new and work on issues that concern me on a more strategic level in the University Board.

There are several issues I am concerned with, and I will mention four of them here. The core of all these cases is that I want all students to feel good, and get the most out of their time here at NMBU. Firstly, I am concerned that we should be the "University of Sustainability", and that environmental, social and economic sustainability should be seen in everything we do. We should continue to work to become a leader in this in research, and it will also be visible in teaching.

Secondly, it is important to work for the community, where everyone is included and feels welcome, regardless of whether you are an international or newly moved veterinary student.

The next thing I think is important is to learn from the experiences we have gained in the corona situation, and that we use these to further develop the digital aids and teaching.

A fourth thing I am concerned about is that there must still be a focus on veterinary students when they come here.

Last but not least, a good learning environment is incredibly important. This includes good mental health among the students, good learning spaces, to support the nice study environment we have here, with teams, organizations and associations, and a good warning systems.

If you want a student voice that is really passionate about the student being heard, then I hope you will give me the confidence by voting for me.
