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> The support from the welfare funds is divided into three categories: basic support (general operating support for all associations), start-up support (additional support for new associations), and activity funds (support for individual activities, upon application with budget). The appendix "Proposal for the distribution of welfare funds" shows the committee's recommendation for the distribution of all funds, while the appendix "Proposal for the distribution of activity funds" shows which associations and activities we propose to allocate activity funds to.

> As part of the assessment of the application, the committee has also assessed which organizations should be awarded the title "open association".

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A total of 81 applications have been received, with a total sum of NOK 1,181,491. As there is only NOK 512 660 to be distributed this time, the committee has had to prioritize quite toughly. In addition to the rules from the regulations, the committee has used the following guidelines to assess the applications:

- A maximum of NOK 2,000 for annual meetings, general assemblies, etc.
- A maximum of NOK 2,000 for activities during buddy week.
- Only academic associations receive funds for Christmas parties. A maximum of NOK 5,000 is allocated for Christmas parties, and a total amount of NOK 7,000 is set aside for Christmas parties, spring parties, summer parties, etc.
- No academic associations receive more than 15,000 in activity funds.
- No associations will receive more than NOK 8000 in activity funds.
  - Exceptions will be made for Studentstorbandet and NMBU Friluftsliv.
  - Open associations may receive up to NOK 9000 in activity funds.
- No associations with more than NOK 100,000 in assets are allocated activity funds.
  - Exceptions are made for the Nordic National Championship and the Veterinary Medicine Student Association.
- Open associations were awarded NOK 800 extra after it had been cut according to the above rules.

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The title open association was awarded according to the guidelines in the regulations, and the following rules:

- Party political organizations are not given the status of an open association
- Associations with Norwegian regional affiliation does not get the status of an open association
- Academic associations do not get the status of an open association
- Other faculty- or department-dependent associations are not given the status of open association

182	Following the discussion on amendments to the statutes at ST1, 15 proposals for amendments to the
183	statutes are now being presented. The proposals with recommendations are in the appendix "Proposal



for amendments of the statutes ". Attached are also the statutes in their entirety, with the proposals marked in pink (deletion) and green (add). Should there be inconsistencies between the two documents, it is the "Proposal of amendments of the statutes" that applies.

These are basically the same proposals that were presented at the previous meeting. In addition, there are two proposals for editorial changes in § 3-4 (proposals 2 and 3), and proposals 13 and 14. Proposal 13 is about being able to adopt particularly relevant resolutions, even if they come in after the case paper deadline. Proposal 14 is a clarification that it is the last decision that applies if the Student Parliament adopts contradictory things in different documents at the same level (two different resolutions or two different political documents).

Proposal for amendment of the statutes must be in the hands of the Student Board no later than 14 days before the Student Parliament meeting. It is therefore not possible to submit amendments to this matter.

#### **Discussion Cases** 2325 291 Work with the Welfare Political Document 2325.1 292 293 Case responsible: The Student Board v/ Helene 294 295 **Purpose:** Discuss what you want a welfare political document to contain 296 297 **Background:** 298 In the action plan for 2023, it was decided that the Student Board will work on getting a welfare political 299 document in place. Political documents must go through two Student Parliament meetings and we will 300 therefore have a discussion about it at Student Parliament meeting 2 and a decision process at Student 301 Parliament meeting 3. 302 A political document is a larger document that should contain the most important politics in that area. 303 Examples of political documents we have are the Students' Learning Environment (adopted 2020) and 304 the Environmental Political Document (adopted 2020). In the preparation of political documents, one 305 must consider that it will be relevant for several years and that further development of politics in the 306 welfare area will be based on this. 307 308 A welfare policy document helps to create more and clearer welfare politics that can be used up towards 309 SiÅs and Ås municipality. Compared to SiÅs, it should deal with the topics; of housing, food, exercise, 310 bookshop, society, health, and other welfare services. Locally in the municipality and nationally, health 311 and transport should be included. 312 In working with the document, the welfare officer wants to gather 3-4 students to review the document 313 before ST3. This is to make the work more thorough with proposals for a platform when going from 314 discussion to decision on a document. The idea is that it should be able to be reviewed in one meeting. 315 316 *We would like you to discuss the questions:* 317 What is needed for the students to be able to live good lives? 318 What is good about SiÅs' offer today, and what should be changed/added/removed? 319 320 The Student Board v/ Helene presented the case. 321 322 The Student Parliament discussed the case. 323 324 325 2325.2 Discussion about the funds for larger learning environment 326 measures 327 Case responsible: The Student Board v/ Helene 328 329 **Purpose:** 330 Discuss what we can suggest to LMU on what we want the funds for larger LMU measures to be used for. 331 **Background:** 332 Every year, a pot of 3.6 million is set aside, which The Learning Environment Committee is responsible 333 for distributing. These funds will go to larger learning environment measures, and in previous years it 334 has gone to outdoor WIFI, a frisbee golf course, and the development of reading rooms and academic 335 homes, among other things (see minutes from LMU for more info). 336 Planning allocation for 2024 will be starting before summer, and therefore we need proposals from The 337 Student Parliament on what the money can be used for. 338

The Student Council with the leader and the deputy leader are responsible for the implementation of the general assembly at their faculty.

The election is done by written or digital voting. If there are less candidates than the number of places, the election can be carried out by acclamation. Representation from several genders and different fields of study must be striven for.

#### Reason:

It is proposed to add a section on how Student Parliament representatives are elected. This is only a formalization of current practice, and will not have any particular practical consequences. The proposal also means that the leader and deputy leader of the Student Councils are held responsible for conducting the general assemblies.

#### § 5-5 Resignation in the Student Board

If a leader or member of the Student Board resigns during the term of office, the Student Parliament appoints a temporary member. The election is held according to the same election rules that apply to ordinary elections in the Student Parliament.

In the event of resignation before the autumn ballot box election, the temporary member sits until a new member is elected in the ballot box election. In the event of resignation after the autumn ballot box election, the temporary member sits for the remainder of the period and until a new Student Board is elected.

If the leader resigns, the leader's deputy will become acting leader until a new leader is elected by ballot box election.

#### Reason:

It is legislated that the highest body of student democracy must be elected from among the students (in ballot box elections). At NMBU, it is interpreted as meaning that this applies to the Student Board. Supplementary elections after someone withdraws should therefore also be done as ballot box elections. At the same time, it is an extensive process to arrange ballot box elections, and it will be demanding for a Student Board which is already short of a person, to do this extraordinarily (apart from the two regular times a year). It is therefore proposed that the Student Parliament should be able to appoint a temporary member of AU, who will sit until the next ordinary ballot box election.

If a resolution is particularly relevant, a decision can be made even if the resolution has been submitted after the case paper deadline. The Student Parliament decides whether they want to make a decision during the constitution.

#### Reason:

Sometimes matters may arise between the case paper deadline and a Student Parliament meeting, which the Student Parliament wants to deal with as soon as possible. If so, it should be dealt with at the next meeting, rather than to make a digital decision or hold an extraordinary meeting. A relevant example is the resolution on school fees from last autumn.

In the event of conflicting decisions, the most recent decision applies, as long as the decisions are made in documents at the same level (ie two different resolutions or two different political platforms).

#### Reason:

It proposes that if the Student Parliament approves contradictory things in different resolutions or political platforms, the most recent decision shall apply. If a conflicting decision is made in a document that is lower in the document hierarchy, it will still be the decision in the higher document that applies. This means that decisions in the program of principles surpass decisions in political platforms and resolutions and that decisions in political platforms surpass decisions in resolutions.

This is a clarification of current practice.

#### **Chapter 3: The Student Parliament**

#### § 3-1 Powers and Functions

The Student Parliament represents all students at NMBU, and decisions made in the Student Parliament are made on the behalf of all students. The Student Parliament has the responsibility to inform about decisions made. Closing of the meeting must follow the provisions in §3-6.

#### § 3-2 Construction

The Faculties at NMBU are constituents of the Student Parliament. The Student Parliament consists of 25 representatives. These representatives are distributed according to the democracy model approved of at Student Parliament 6 in 2016.

The division method for the mandatory seat allocation follows this formula:

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615 <u>V</u> 616 2s+1

- V= Number of students at the faculty
- 619 S= Number of student representatives the faculty is allocated

Updated number of students can be found in the Database for Statistics on Higher Education (DBH) every fall. The average of the number of students for the spring semester and fall semester make up the basis for the following year's representative distribution in the Student Parliament.

This calculation basis is presented for orientation before the fall faculty general assemblies.

#### § 3-X Election of representatives

Substitute Student Parliament representatives are elected at open student general meetings in each faculty. The date for the general meetings is decided as a general rule in the date plan adopted by the Student Parliament. The Student Council head and deputy head are responsible for the implementation of the general assembly at their faculty.

The choice is made by written or digital voting. If there are not more candidates than the number of positions, the election can be carried out by acclamation. One must try to ensure representation from several genders and different fields of study.

#### § 3-3 Constituting

The Student Parliament representatives are elected for one year at the time. One should aim for the constituent Student Parliament to be held between the fall faculty general assemblies and the new year. § 3-4 Meetings and Summoning

 The Student Parliament must hold at least 3 meetings per semester. The Student Board is responsible for summoning the Student Parliament. Summoning and case papers should be made available to all students at least 7 days before the meeting. Electronic decisions are the exclusion of this statute cf. §3-10.

 The provision that the summoning and case papers need to be made available for all students in the first paragraph entails that they need to be translated to English. If there is uncertainty about the translation, the Norwegian version will be the basis for understanding. Further specification is outlined in the instructions for the Student Parliament.

All students with a valid semester registration have the right to send in cases to the Student Parliament. This must be done at the latest 14 days before the meeting if the case is to be handled. This provision does not count for cases to be handled under "other." Further specification is outlined in the instructions for the Student Parliament. Extraordinary Student Parliaments is held if at least 3 members of the Student



Board, at leas 13 representatives from the Student Parliament, or at least 25 students desire it. Extraordinary Student Parliament is to be made known to the public at least 7 days before taking place, and should only handle the case(s) that were the reason for its summoning.

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#### § 3-5 Representation at the

- Representation at the Student Parliament
- The following people are required to attend Student Parliament, and are required to give a written notification before the meeting if they cannot attend:
- The Student Parliament's Representatives
  - The Student Parliament's Student Board
  - The Student Parliament's organizational secretary
  - The Student Parliament's chairmen

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- At least one representative from the following organs must attend the meeting:
- The Student Representative in the University Board
  - The Student Representative in the SiÅs board
  - The International Student Union (ISU)
- 671 The Control Committee
- All students at NMBU have the right to attend the Student Parliament.

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#### § 3-6 Closing of a Meeting.

The Student Parliament's meetings are open. The Student Parliament can decide to close a meeting with a qualified majority from the representatives in attendance

With the closing of a meeting, separate minutes will be recorded that are withheld from public disclosure.

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#### § 3-7 Decision Validity

The Student Parliament can make valid decisions when at least 50% of the representatives are in attendance.

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#### § 3-8 Voting rights and Voting

The Student Parliament's representatives have a voting right. If a main representative notifies of an absence, their appointed substitute has a voting right when in attendance. Decisions in the Student Parliament are normally made with a 50% majority. Decisions are made with hand raising, unless one representative asks for a written voting. With a voting tie, the Student Parliament can take a new vote. With a continued tie after a second voting, the case can be handled according to the proposed resolution.

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#### §3-9 Speaking and Proposal Rights

Everybody has a right to speak at Student parliament meetings. All students at NMBU has the right to propose cases at Student parliament meetings.

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#### § 3-10 Electronic Voting

Electronic voting can be used to make decisions about single cases. Electronic voting is carried out in the method described in the instructions for electronic voting. The deadline to vote electronically is within 7 days.

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- Electronic voting cannot be used to vote on matters concerning the following:
- 701 Elections
- 702 Cases of mistrust
- Changing to the Student Parliament's committee documents and instructions
- Appointment of the student representatives to councils and committees
- 705 Other matters of considerable nature

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Main Student Parliament Representatives have voting rights with electronic voting.



Electronic voting cannot take place if one or some student parliament representatives wish to handle the case at a normal student parliament before the deadline. The desire must be justified.

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### § 3-11 Position Resignation

- The Student Parliament representatives automatically resign from their position in the Student Parliament when they are elected to the following organs:
- The Student Parliament's Student Board
- 716 The University Board
- 717 The SiÅs Board
  - The Student Board of the Norwegian Student Organization
- 719 The Control Committee

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# Student Parliament representatives also automatically resign their seats if they are no longer students at the university.

Student Parliament representatives also resigns their positions automatically if they switch to another Faculty than the one they were elected to represent If a Student Parliament representative changes faculty, that person can remain in office until supplementary elections can be held at the next general meeting. In that case, they will remain in office as a representative of their old faculty. Alternatively, they may resign their seat.

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With position resignation, the position holder's deputy representative automatically inherits the position as a main representative.

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Position resignation, a supplementary election will be conducted in accordance with § 5-5

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#### §3-12 Temporary Position Resignation

In the case of partiality, there will be a temporary place resignation. This means that the representative withdraws from their position in cases where it applies. In the case of temporary place resignation the deputy will take over cf. § 6-1

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#### **Chapter 4: The Student Parliament's Student Board**

#### § 4-1 Powers and Functions

The Student Board (AU) carries out the Student Parliament's daily operations and represents the Student Parliament between meetings. AU can make decisions in urgent cases, cases that are delegated due to earlier decisions in the Student Parliament, and appoint people to non-decision making committees. AU makes proposals in all cases handled by the Student Parliament, with the exception of Elections.

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#### § 4-2 Composition

The Student Parliament's Student Board shall consist of the following members:

- 749 President
- 750 AU member
- 751 AU member

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 $The \ Student \ Board \ constitutes \ their \ areas \ of \ responsibility \ internally.$ 

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Working time and election periods are regulated according to functions § 5-1.

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## § 4-3 Decision Ability and Voting Ties



The Student Board can make valid decisions when at least four members are in attendance. With a voting tie in the Student Board, the president has a double vote.

§ 4-4 Editorial authority

Usually, The Student Board has editorial authority to correct typographical errors in all adopted documents, unless otherwise decided by the Student Parliament. The authorization only applies to minor linguistic changes. Substantive changes can only be made by a new decision in the Student Parliament. The date of changes must be listed at the top of the document, under information about when the document was adopted.

#### **Chapter 5: Elections and Appointments**

#### § 5-1 Eligibility for the Student Democracy

The overarching rule is that all Students at NMBU with a valid semester registration can run for positions in the Student Democracy. This applies unless otherwise specified.

#### § 5-2 Electronic Ballot Elections

#### a) Election of the Student Parliament's Student Board

The Student Parliament's Student Board are elected through Electronic Ballot Voting, where all students with a valid semester registration have the right to vote. The Electronic Ballot Election take place in April every year. They hold their position for 1 year, between 1.7. until 30.6. Candidates who apply must be able to master Norwegian as a working language.

#### b) Election to the University Board

Two student representatives are elected, one of each legal gender, with a deputy. They are chosen through an Electronic Ballot vote, where all students with a valid semester registration have the right to vote. The election takes place every year in April/May and in November. They hold the position for one year, from 01.07 to 30.06 for the spring election, and 01.01-31.12 for the fall election.

#### c) Elections to the Faculty Board

Two student representatives, on of each legal gender, are elected with personal substitute to the seven Faculty Boards (FS). These are elected by electronic urn election, where all semester-registered students at the relevant faculty have the right to vote. A student only has the right to vote in one faculty board election. The Electronic Ballot election takes place every year in April / May and November. The position time for the elected is 1 year and lasts from 01.07. to 30.06 for the spring election, and 01.01-31.12 for the autumn election. Candidates of a gender other than the representative who already sits on the board are eligible to stand for election at a given semester.

#### § 5-3 Other elections and appointments conducted in the Student Parliament

The Student Parliament elects student representatives to central positions and committees at NMBU, to individual committees and to the board for student welfare organization. All elections are done by writing. In the case that only one candidate is running for one position, they can be elected by acclamation, unless at least one representative wishes to have a written voting process.

With a tie in voting between two candidates, a new voting round will be held. With a continued tie after a new voting round, the decision will be made according to the proposed resolution. If there is no suggestion made the decision will be made by drawing lots. Those chosen in this paragraph have minute requirements to the Student Parliament.

Student Representatives that are not connected to the Student Welfare Organization in Ås (SiÅs) do not have voting rights for the representatives of The SiÅs Board.



### 809 § 5-4 Resignation of position and Supplementary Elections

Normally, a supplementary election will be held in the case of place resignation from positions elected by the Student Parliament. Supplementary elections follow the same election rules as normal elections. This can be adjusted in cases of urgent votes, a short time left of the time period of the position, or other reasons in which it is appropriate.

In the event of a resignation from a position elected at a general meeting, the substitute member will move to the permanent position. Alternatively, the Student Council can appoint a temporary representative who sits until the next general meeting. This also applies if positions are empty because they were not filled at the general meeting, as long as the general meeting has not decided otherwise.

#### § 5-5 Resignation of position in the Student Board

If a leader or member of the Student Board resigns during the term of office, the Student Parliament appoints a temporary member. The election is made according to the same election rules that apply to ordinary elections in the Student Parliament.

In the event of resignation before the autumn ballot election, the temporary member sits until a new member is elected in the ballot election. In the event of resignation after the autumn ballot box election, the temporary member sits for the remainder of the period and until a new Student Board takes office.

If the leader resigns, the leader's deputy will become acting leader until a new leader is elected by ballot.

#### **Chapter 6: Impartiality**

### § 6-1 Impartiality

For someone to be "partial" entails that there are circumstances that are likely to cause bias in the person's judgment. This can happen when a person is a part of a case or has strong personal consequences from the results of a case, or has close family with the previously mentioned.

In order to have good administrative practices, questions of partiality must be strict. This means that a lot must happen to name a representative partial. Those that are named partial must temporarily resign from the case, cf.§ 3-12.

Cases of partiality are handled with a 50% majority voting from the relevant organ, and the person in question cannot vote. If more than one person in a case is questioned about partiality, none of the involved can partake in voting about their own or others' partiality, unless the organ is no longer a decision making organ in the case. In this case, all meeting members can participate.

#### **Chapter 7: Mistrust**

#### § 7-1 Mistrust

Issues of mistrust can be brought up by Student Parliament representatives or other organs of the Student Democracy, and should be delivered to the Student Parliament's organizational secretary. When handling these issues at the student parliament, the one that the case is brought up against has the opportunity to present their own case.

#### § 7-2 Ability to ask for a statement from the control committee

If cases where mistrust are brought forward, both parties can ask for a statement from the control committee in sufficient time before the case is handled.

### § 7-3 Issues of mistrust against the representatives chosen by the student parliament

With a 2/3 majority vote amongst representatives in attendance, the student parliament can decide that an officer is mistrusted, following statutes §§ 5-1 second paragraph, and 5-3. Those who are deemed distrusted must immediately resign as an appointee from the student parliament



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## §8-1-4 Resolutions

#### § 7-4 Issues of mistrust against the representatives chosen by Electronic Ballot Voting

With issues of mistrust against representatives chosen through electronic ballot voting after statues §§ 5-2 a and b, it is handled first by the Student Parliament. If it is proposed by a qualified majority amongst representatives in attendance, it will be handled through an electronic ballot vote where all students with a valid semester registration have the right to vote. The approval of the mistrust requires at least a 50% majority of votes. Those who have cases of mistrust approved against them must resign immediately from their position.

Cases of mistrust cannot be taken against student representatives in the University Board, as it goes against Lov om universiteter og høyskoler § 9-8. (The laws for Universities and Higher schools)

#### § 8-1-1 Statutes

The statutes outrank all other management documents.

### § 8-1-2 Program of Principles

The Program of Principles determines the organization's ground principles and executive political priorities. The Program of Principles outranks the rest of the Student Parliament's politics.

The Program of Principles shall be treated every 5th year. The Student Parliament can choose to treat the Program of Principles at any time. The Program of Principles shall be treated in two student parliament meetings: with a discussion case in the first meeting and a decision case in the second meeting.

#### § 8-1-3 Political platforms

Political platforms determine what the Student Parliament thinks of a certain topic. These shall not go against the Program of Principles, but outside of this, political platforms outrank the rest of the Student Parliament's politics. A document is valid for 5 years. Political platforms shall be processed in two student parliament meetings: with a discussion case in the first meeting, and a decision case in the second meeting.



Resolutions stipulates what the Student Parliament believes in a particular case. Resolutions can be processed directly.

#### § 8-2 Instructions for the Student Councils

The Student Parliament adopts a standardized instruction for the composition of student councils at NMBU. The Student Parliament decides the structure and composition of Student Councils. The Student Councils have the power to make their own local instructions, but not remove or change the composition without approval from the Student Parliament.

#### § 8-3 Other Instructions

The Student Parliament can approve of other instructions as needed.

## **Chapter 9: Dissolution of the Student Democracy at NMBU**

§ 9-1 Dissolution

Dissolution of the Student Democracy at NMBU must be approved of with a qualified majority amongst present representatives for two consecutive student parliaments. The decision goes into effect after the second meeting is adjourned. Proposals for dissolution must be made at least 4 weeks before it is handled for the first time, and the first student parliament meeting that handles the case is to be an open meeting where all students at NMBU are called in.

#### § 9-2 Merging with Other Student Democracies

Merging of the Student Democracy at NMBU with other student democracies must be approved of with a qualified majority amongst representatives in attendance for two consecutive meetings. Proposals for merging must specify the point in time at which the merge will take place.

#### **Chapter 10: Membership in the Norwegian Student Organization**

§ 10-1 Membership in the Norwegian Student Organization

The Student Democracy at NMBU is a member of the Norwegian student organization (NSO). Withdrawal must follow the protocol of NSOs statutes.

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## **Chapter 11: Amendments to the Statues**

§ 11-1 Submitting of Amendment Proposals

Proposals for amendments of these statutes should be taken to the Student Parliament's Student Board at least 14 days before the meeting in which they will be addressed, and needs to be made public to all students at least 7 days before the meeting.

### § 11-2 Decisions and Effectiveness

With a qualified majority vote amongst representatives in attendance, the Student Parliament can decide that changes go into effect immediately after they are adopted

 With a qualified majority, the Student Parliament can bring changed into effect. The Student Parliament's Student Board has the power to make editorial changes in these Statutes. Such changes must be presented for orientation during the first meeting after they are made.

## **Chapter 12: Definitions**

§ 12-1 Majority Voting

According to the student package itself, 125,000 packages are distributed each year. All of this eventually ends up as waste, much of it unused. The fact that there is already an app where you can find the discounts available in the student package makes the distribution of physical coupons particularly unfunny.

To avoid the individual players in the student package creating their own student-oriented advertising campaigns, it is not enough to simply say that the student package is not desired. You have to say no to advertising on campus.

The University of Oslo has the following guidelines on advertising: "The University of Oslo must have an advertising-free campus. Sales, profiling, dissemination of information, and promotion of recruitment are not permitted. In connection with events, it is possible to apply to the Property Department for permission for relevant activities." Furthermore, they write: "Sales, marketing events, distribution of flyers and product samples or recruitment promotion that is not part of an event, is not permitted on UiO's property."

#### The Student Parliament wants that:

- NMBU must be an advertising-free campus
- The Student Board must work to ensure that more Student Democracies adopt advertising-free campuses

#### 1066 Chapter 3: The Student Parliament

#### § 3-1 Powers and Functions

The Student Parliament represents all students at NMBU, and decisions made in the Student Parliament are made on the behalf of all students. The Student Parliament has the responsibility to inform about decisions made. Closing of the meeting must follow the provisions in §3-6.

#### § 3-2 Construction

The Faculties at NMBU are constituents of the Student Parliament. The Student Parliament consists of 25 representatives. These representatives are distributed according to the democracy model approved of at Student Parliament 6 in 2016.

 The division method for the mandatory seat allocation follows this formula:

Updated number of students can be found in the Database for Statistics on Higher Education (DBH) every fall. The average of the number of students for the spring semester and fall semester make up the basis for the following year's representative distribution in the Student Parliament.

This calculation basis is presented for orientation before the fall faculty general assemblies.

## § 3-3 Election of representatives

Substitute Student Parliament representatives are elected at open student general meetings in each faculty. The date for the general meetings is decided as a general rule in the date plan adopted by the Student Parliament. The Student Council head and deputy head are responsible for the implementation of the general assembly at their faculty.

The choice is made by written or digital voting. If there are not more candidates than the number of positions, the election can be carried out by acclamation. One must try to ensure representation from several genders and different fields of study.

### § 3-4Constituting

The Student Parliament representatives are elected for one year at the time. One should aim for the constituent Student Parliament to be held between the fall faculty general assemblies and the new year.

#### § 3-5 Meetings and Summoning

The Student Parliament must hold at least 3 meetings per semester. The Student Board is responsible for summoning the Student Parliament. Summoning and case papers should be made available to all students at least 7 days before the meeting. Electronic decisions are the exclusion of this statute cf. §3-10.

The provision that the summoning and case papers need to be made available for all students in the first paragraph entails that they need to be translated to English. If there is uncertainty about the translation, the Norwegian version will be the basis for understanding. Further specification is outlined in the instructions for the Student Parliament.

All students with a valid semester registration have the right to send in cases to the Student Parliament.
This must be done at the latest 14 days before the meeting if the case is to be handled. This provision does not count for cases to be handled under "other." Further specification is outlined in the instructions for the Student Parliament. Extraordinary Student Parliaments is held if at least 3 members of the Student

Board, at leas 13 representatives from the Student Parliament, or at least 25 students desire it.

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#### § 3-8 Decision Validity

The Student Parliament can make valid decisions when at least 50% of the representatives are in attendance.

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#### § 3-9 Voting rights and Voting

- The Student Parliament's representatives have a voting right. If a main representative notifies of an absence, their appointed substitute has a voting right when in attendance. Decisions in the Student
- 1149 1150 Parliament are normally made with a 50% majority. Decisions are made with hand raising, unless one
- 1151 representative asks for a written voting. With a voting tie, the Student Parliament can take a new vote.
- 1152 With a continued tie after a second voting, the case can be handled according to the proposed resolution.

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#### §3-10 Speaking and Proposal Rights

Everybody has a right to speak at Student parliament meetings. All students at NMBU has the right to propose cases at Student parliament meetings.

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#### § 3-11 Electronic Voting

Electronic voting can be used to make decisions about single cases. Electronic voting is carried out in the method described in the instructions for electronic voting. The deadline to vote electronically is within 7

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- Electronic voting cannot be used to vote on matters concerning the following:
- 1165 - Elections
  - Cases of mistrust
- 1167 - Changing to the Student Parliament's committee documents and instructions
- 1168 - Appointment of the student representatives to councils and committees
- 1169 - Other matters of considerable nature

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Main Student Parliament Representatives have voting rights with electronic voting.



Electronic voting cannot take place if one or some student parliament representatives wish to handle the case at a normal student parliament before the deadline. The desire must be justified.

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#### § 3-12 Position Resignation

- The Student Parliament representatives automatically resign from their position in the Student Parliament when they are elected to the following organs:
  - The Student Parliament's Student Board
- 1180 The University Board
- 1181 The SiÅs Board
  - The Student Board of the Norwegian Student Organization
- 1183 The Control Committee

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- Student Parliament representatives also automatically resign their seats if they are no longer students at the university.
- If a Student Parliament representative changes faculty, that person can remain in office until supplementary elections can be held at the next general meeting. In that case, they will remain in office as a representative of their old faculty. Alternatively, they may resign their seat.

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With position resignation, the position holder's deputy representative automatically inherits the position as a main representative.

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#### §3-13 Temporary Position Resignation

In the case of partiality, there will be a temporary place resignation. This means that the representative withdraws from their position in cases where it applies. In the case of temporary place resignation the deputy will take over cf. § 6-1

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#### 1199 Chapter 4: The Student Parliament's Student Board

#### § 4-1 Powers and Functions

The Student Board (AU) carries out the Student Parliament's daily operations and represents the Student Parliament between meetings. AU can make decisions in urgent cases, cases that are delegated due to earlier decisions in the Student Parliament, and appoint people to non-decision making committees. AU makes proposals in all cases handled by the Student Parliament, with the exception of Elections.

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#### § 4-2 Composition

- The Student Parliament's Student Board shall consist of the following members:
- 1208 President
- 1209 AU member
- 1210 AU member

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1212 The Student Board constitutes their areas of responsibility internally.

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Working time and election periods are regulated according to functions § 5-1.

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### 1216 § 4-3 Decision Ability and Voting Ties

The Student Board can make valid decisions when at least four members are in attendance. With a voting tie in the Student Board, the president has a double vote.

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#### § 4-4 Editorial authority

- Usually, The Student Board has editorial authority to correct typographical errors in all adopted
- documents, unless otherwise decided by the Student Parliament. The authorization only applies to minor
- linguistic changes. Changes in the content can only be made by a new decision in the Student Parliament.



1224 The date of changes must be listed at the top of the document, under information about when the 1225 document was adopted.

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## **Chapter 5: Elections and Appointments**

#### § 5-1 Eligibility for the Student Democracy

The overarching rule is that all Students at NMBU with a valid semester registration can run for positions in the Student Democracy. This applies unless otherwise specified.

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#### § 5-2 Electronic Ballot Elections

#### a) Election of the Student Parliament's Student Board

The Student Parliament's Student Board are elected through Electronic Ballot Voting, where all students with a valid semester registration have the right to vote. The Electronic Ballot Election take place in April every year. They hold their position for 1 year, between 1.7. until 30.6. Candidates who apply must be able to master Norwegian as a working language.

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#### b) Election to the University Board

Two student representatives are elected, one of each legal gender, with a deputy. They are chosen through an Electronic Ballot vote, where all students with a valid semester registration have the right to vote. The election takes place every year in April/May and in November. They hold the position for one year, from 01.07 to 30.06 for the spring election, and 01.01-31.12 for the fall election.

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#### c) Elections to the Faculty Board

Two student representatives, on of each legal gender, are elected with personal substitute to the seven Faculty Boards (FS). These are elected by electronic urn election, where all semester-registered students at the relevant faculty have the right to vote. A student only has the right to vote in one faculty board election. The Electronic Ballot election takes place every year in April / May and November. The position time for the elected is 1 year and lasts from 01.07. to 30.06 for the spring election, and 01.01-31.12 for the autumn election. Candidates of a gender other than the representative who already sits on the board are eligible to stand for election at a given semester.

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## § 5-3 Other elections and appointments conducted in the Student Parliament

The Student Parliament elects student representatives to central positions and committees at NMBU, to individual committees and to the board for student welfare organization. All elections are done by writing. In the case that only one candidate is running for one position, they can be elected by acclamation, unless at least one representative wishes to have a written voting process.

With a tie in voting between two candidates, a new voting round will be held. With a continued tie after a new voting round, the decision will be made according to the proposed resolution. If there is no suggestion made the decision will be made by drawing lots. Those chosen in this paragraph have minute requirements to the Student Parliament.

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#### 1267 § 5-4 Resignation of position and Supplementary Elections

Normally, a supplementary election will be held in the case of place resignation from positions elected by the Student Parliament. Supplementary elections follow the same election rules as normal elections. This can be adjusted in cases of urgent votes, a short time left of the time period of the position, or other reasons in which it is appropriate.

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In the event of a resignation from a position elected at a general meeting, the substitute member will move to the permanent position. Alternatively, the Student Council can appoint a temporary



representative who sits until the next general meeting. This also applies if positions are empty because they were not filled at the general meeting, as long as the general meeting has not decided otherwise.

#### § 5-5 Resignation of position in the Student Board

If a leader or member of the Student Board resigns during the term of office, the Student Parliament appoints a temporary member. The election is made according to the same election rules that apply to ordinary elections in the Student Parliament.

In the event of resignation before the autumn ballot election, the temporary member sits until a new member is elected in the ballot election. In the event of resignation after the autumn ballot box election, the temporary member sits for the remainder of the period and until a new Student Board takes office.

If the leader resigns, the leader's deputy will become acting leader until a new leader is elected by ballot.

## **Chapter 6: Impartiality**

#### § 6-1 Impartiality

For someone to be "partial" entails that there are circumstances that are likely to cause bias in the person's judgment. This can happen when a person is a part of a case or has strong personal consequences from the results of a case, or has close family with the previously mentioned.

In order to have good administrative practices, questions of partiality must be strict. This means that a lot must happen to name a representative partial. Those that are named partial must temporarily resign from the case, cf.§ 3-12.

Cases of partiality are handled with a 50% majority voting from the relevant organ, and the person in question cannot vote. If more than one person in a case is questioned about partiality, none of the involved can partake in voting about their own or others' partiality, unless the organ is no longer a decision making organ in the case. In this case, all meeting members can participate.

#### **Chapter 7: Mistrust**

#### § 7-1 Mistrust

Issues of mistrust can be brought up by Student Parliament representatives or other organs of the Student Democracy, and should be delivered to the Student Parliament's organizational secretary. When handling these issues at the student parliament, the one that the case is brought up against has the opportunity to present their own case.

#### § 7-2 Ability to ask for a statement from the control committee

If cases where mistrust are brought forward, both parties can ask for a statement from the control committee in sufficient time before the case is handled.

#### § 7-3 Issues of mistrust against the representatives chosen by the student parliament

With a 2/3 majority vote amongst representatives in attendance, the student parliament can decide that an officer is mistrusted, following statutes §§ 5-1 second paragraph, and 5-3. Those who are deemed distrusted must immediately resign as an appointee from the student parliament

### § 7-4 Issues of mistrust against the representatives chosen by Electronic Ballot Voting

With issues of mistrust against representatives chosen through electronic ballot voting after statues §§ 5-2 a and b, it is handled first by the Student Parliament. If it is proposed by a qualified majority amongst representatives in attendance, it will be handled through an electronic ballot vote where all students with a valid semester registration have the right to vote. The approval of the mistrust requires at least a 50% majority of votes. Those who have cases of mistrust approved against them must resign immediately from their position.



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Cases of mistrust cannot be taken against student representatives in the University Board, as it goes against Lov om universiteter og høyskoler § 9-8. (The laws for Universities and Higher schools)

## § 8-1 Documents approved by Student Parliament

The following documents are to be approved by the Student Parliament:

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#### § 8-1-1 Statutes

The statutes outrank all other management documents.

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#### § 8-1-2 Program of Principles

The Program of Principles determines the organization's ground principles and executive political priorities. The Program of Principles outranks the rest of the Student Parliament's politics.

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The Program of Principles shall be treated every 5th year. The Student Parliament can choose to treat the Program of Principles at any time. The Program of Principles shall be treated in two student parliament meetings: with a discussion case in the first meeting and a decision case in the second meeting.

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### § 8-1-3 Political platforms

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against the Program of Principles, but outside of this, political platforms outrank the rest of the Student Parliament's politics. A document is valid for 5 years. Political platforms shall be processed in two student parliament meetings: with a discussion case in the first meeting, and a decision case in the second meeting.

Political platforms determine what the Student Parliament thinks of a certain topic. These shall not go

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#### §8-1-4 Resolutions

1371 1372 Resolutions stipulates what the Student Parliament believes in a particular case. Resolutions can be processed directly.

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#### § 8-3 Other Instructions

1375 The Student Parliament can approve of other instructions as needed.

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#### 1379 **Chapter 9: Dissolution of the Student Democracy at NMBU** 1380

#### § 9-1 Dissolution

Dissolution of the Student Democracy at NMBU must be approved of with a qualified majority amongst present representatives for two consecutive student parliaments. The decision goes into effect after the second meeting is adjourned. Proposals for dissolution must be made at least 4 weeks before it is handled for the first time, and the first student parliament meeting that handles the case is to be an open meeting where all students at NMBU are called in.

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#### § 9-2 Merging with Other Student Democracies

Merging of the Student Democracy at NMBU with other student democracies must be approved of with a qualified majority amongst representatives in attendance for two consecutive meetings. Proposals for merging must specify the point in time at which the merge will take place.

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## **Chapter 10: Membership in the Norwegian Student Organization**

#### § 10-1 Membership in the Norwegian Student Organization

The Student Democracy at NMBU is a member of the Norwegian student organization (NSO). Withdrawal must follow the protocol of NSOs statutes.

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#### **Chapter 11: Amendments to the Statues**

#### § 11-1 Submitting of Amendment Proposals

Proposals for amendments of these statutes should be taken to the Student Parliament's Student Board at least 14 days before the meeting in which they will be addressed, and needs to be made public to all students at least 7 days before the meeting.

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### § 11-2 Decisions and Effectiveness

With a qualified majority vote amongst representatives in attendance, the Student Parliament can decide that changes go into effect immediately after they are adopted

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With a qualified majority, the Student Parliament can bring changed into effect. The Student Parliament's Student Board has the power to make editorial changes in these Statutes. Such changes must be presented for orientation during the first meeting after they are made.

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## **Chapter 12: Definitions**

## § 12-1 Majority Voting

- Simple Majority: This means that a proposal receives the most votes
- 50% majority: This means that a proposal receives more than ½ of the votes from participating voters

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Qualified Majority: This means that a proposal receives 2/3 or more of the votes from the participating voters

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1421 Absolute Majority: A proposal receives more than ½ of the total number of votes

1422 Absolute Qualified Majority: A proposal receives 2/3 or more of the total number of votes
