P. 4 Activity plan and budget

Short presentation of Activity plan and Budget.

The Boards' comments under point A were presented and accepted.

Short comments on the suggestion from NSF to run more courses with lesser budgets. Shall be considered for next period.

Information about the support from SNS in the forest area, 30 000 NOK per course in the area, during 3 years.

So far one application deadline (April 15, 2006). Should we have two deadlines, the second on Oct 15? October may be a better time, not so many other application deadlines.

Information about the next NOVA application for Marie Curie (EU) funding, deadline May 2006.

Comments that questions the idea to have two deadlines, better to keep one time. Must make plans quite long time ahead. More work for KUF. More difficult to compare quality.

What do we do with the rejected applications.

Deadline even before April 15? Decision in the April meeting?

No further comments.

<u>Decision</u>: we keep to the same deadline, one time a year.

No comments on point C.

Some short comments under point D.

The same administrative problems turn up within NOVA and ELLS.

NOVA should also compare administrative rules for MSc level education. See ELLS form.

<u>Decision:</u> keep in mind the discussion on administrative matters. Compare rules for MSc according to the ELLS form.

Short information about the discussion in the Board about NOVA-BOVA cooperation and about the evaluation of NOVA.

NOVA seminar, 18-19 of May, preliminary on the Färö islands.

No comments from KUF on point E.

No comments on the budget suggestion.

Correct NLH and LBH.

Point 5. Applications.

VIELO

Short presentation.

Project in the pilot phase, when problems are solved then a full network will be contacted. Perhaps organize a distance learning course.

<u>Decision:</u> to accept NOVA rector suggestion, incl comments about the NOVA team (15.500 €).

NOVA vet 2006

Short presentation. Possibility to define a NOVA window, in August and January. Two MSc course run during the fall 2005, one in June 2006 and three have planning grants.

G Dalin has written a report on comparing European curricula.

Decision: to accept NOVA rector suggestion (25.000 €).

Agroecology

Responsibility from UMB to SLU (Lennart Salomonsson). Agreement from SLU faculty to give this area a high priority.

We have reasons to believe that the area takes the Nordic cooperation seriously.

Do we have problems with different legislations about the possibility to put up joint degrees? We come back to this discussion.

Decision: to accept NOVA rector suggestion, incl a maximum limit of two years. (25.000 €).

Apiculture

Small/narrow area, good for Nordic cooperation.

Short explanation from UMB about the small environment.

<u>Decision:</u> to accept NOVA rector suggestion. (16.000 €).

NOVA Pedictnet

Good activities shown.

OK for a competition.

<u>Decision:</u> to accept NOVA rector suggestion (use available funds).

Library network

Good interaction between Library and Pedictnet, and several other networks.

<u>Decision:</u> to accept NOVA rector suggestion (6.900 €).

Plant fibre (PhD course)

Old application (from June). Still a weak network.

Due to new information about rejected NordForsk funding of an IT course, NOVA rector suggest that we still wait for the amount of regained before we accept funding for this course. Meantime we ask for a stronger network.

<u>Decision:</u> to accept the new suggestion, to postpone the decision and wait for eventual regained funding.

Point 6. NOVA PhD courses

Short presentation from NOVA rector.

Less good jobs in the networks when it comes to marketing of the courses.

Suggestions from NSF correlates good with NOVA rector suggestions.

Presentation of the idea to use the NOVA PhD database to get in closer contacts with potential PhD students.

Number of PhD students decrease at KVL and SLU. Good support for research schools at both SLU and KVL.

Combine NOVA courses with courses in research schools.

Contact between head of research schools and NOVA.

Can NOVA give co-funding to national research school funded courses?

We must find ways to see where the demand for courses is? Use the network database more active.

The short intensive form is very much appreciated.

The networks must be made visible.

Comments that the rotating principle is very good for taking responsibility for courses.

In very small areas we may look for students even outside NOVA.

Show the number of students from various countries.

NOVA supports students from non NOVA courses. Should they have to pay a fee? Quite many students come from the Baltic countries.

We should come back to the matter of fee for external students at the next KUF meeting.

National differences in the rules of funding PhD courses/students.

<u>Decision:</u> agree that NOVA rector continues with suggested activities. Come back to the matter at the next KUF meeting.

Point 7. Funding of Intensive MSc Courses

Short introduction.

More general discussion about the question on if we really want to start this procedure. This is a new initiative, do we want to start before the evaluation?

Unsynchronized semester periods!!

Summer schools.

NOVA windows within the Vet area.

Students have been very positive to the concept of NOVA windows. Probably best suited for the Vet area.

Landscape architects already use this concept.

Some topics with international interest are suitable for summer time concept.

NOVA Vet still holds on to the idea of Windows in Aug and January.

Students still wish to support the idea of NOVA Windows.

HU-V have had elective courses in Jan for many years. Also UMB.

Applications for evaluation. Deadline for application by Jan 15. Coord with application to Nordplus.

Open announcement for any area, not more than 2 pages.

We should avoid cash handling.

<u>Decision:</u> to announce for three pilot projects during 2006, deadline for application Jan 15, 2006.

Point 8. Mutual course recognition

Short introduction, summary of the discussion in NOVA Board.

Discussion from different angles on the MCR problem.

Decision:

- Agree to continue with the process in Aquaculture and NORBE, small report to KUF next meeting. Agreement in the scientific network is finally decided in national study committees.
- Permission for chair and rector to formulate the new strategic goal.

What is a joint degree? Can we use the same definition in the Lisboan agreement?

We need to find out the positions in each member country. Facts to the next KUF meeting.

See definition from ELLS.

Concentrate on cooperation on course level, giving a degree is not a problem.

Point 9. Mobility in Erasmus and NOVA

Short presentation.

Not a good idea to have mutual agreements, we should make bilateral agreements between individual universities.

We can just add new areas in old agreements. Both systems, central or on department level exists.

Scientific environment come up with the idea of signing agreements, but the formal agreement should be signed by the central administration.

Information to the networks about formalities.

Is it possible to see from which areas the students come?

Decision:

- Bilateral agreements between NOVA members
- We can add new areas in old agreements
- Initiative from networks, administrated on central level.
